



Assumption College – Enrolment Policy

Assumption College is a Catholic Co-educational Day and Boarding School founded by the Marist Brothers in 1893.

The College Enrolment Policy for year 7 caters for students in the following categories:

1. Catholic students from Catholic Primary Schools
2. Catholic students from Non-Catholic Primary Schools
3. Siblings of students currently enrolled at the College
4. Sons and daughters (grandsons / granddaughters) of Old Scholars
5. Non-Catholic students from Catholic Primary Schools
6. Non-Catholic students from Non-Catholic Primary Schools

Parents are advised to apply for enrolment when their child is in Grade 5.

Preference in admission is given to families who are actively associated with the Catholic Church and are able to include a Parish Priest Reference in their enrolment application.

Decisions regarding the acceptance or otherwise of an application are taken at the discretion of the Principal.
